Gateshead Railway Quarter

Under the railway arches between Axis & Microbus, you can find the all-new **Victor Indigo November** wine shop and tasting room, and the ever so delicious all-vegan **Big Fat Donut Co.**

The Split Chimp

A micropub located in the railway arches on Newcastle's Westgate Street, a short walk from Newcastle Central Station: come out of the front of the station and turn right, following the railway line alongside the buildings and arches towards Newcastle Castle.

Axis

A small neighbourhood bar and bottle shop in the first railway arch on Wellington Street on the Gateshead side of the High Level Bridge.

Microbus

A VW Microbus themed Micropub, with added bus, on Wellington Street, Gateshead, just 8 arches along from Axis.

4

The Central Bar

Gateshead Ale House set in an iconic 'flat iron' style Victorian Building, including roof top bar overlooking the local railway lines. Located on Half Moon Lane, just around the corner from Microbus.

Station East

A small pub set inside the railway arches across from the old Gateshead East station (closed in 1981) on Hills Street, across the road from The Central Bar and around the corner from Microbus.

Beer Street

A micropub bar located under the railway arches back on the Newcastle side of the river, on Forth Street which is accessible by walking under the Clavering Place railway arch. The bar faces the site of the former Stephenson Railway Works.

Mosaic Tap

A railway arch bar located in Arch 7, Forth Goods Yard behind Newcastle's Centre for Life.

Within an easy 5 minute walk to & from Newcastle Central Station, it has a live digital display of train departures so you can enjoy your beer in good time for your train.

To walk here from Beer Street continue down to the end of Forth Street and under the railway bridges (by the police station) to get to the arches on the other side of the railway line.
